Psalm 47:1-9 Come, everyone! Clap your hands! Shout to God with joyful praise! ² For the LORD Most High is awesome. He is the great King of all the earth. ³ He subdues the nations before us, putting our enemies beneath our feet. ⁴ He chose the Promised Land as our inheritance, the proud possession of Jacob's descendants, whom he loves. ⁵ God has ascended with a mighty shout. The LORD has ascended with trumpets blaring. ⁶ Sing praises to God, sing praises; sing praises to our King, sing praises! ⁷ For God is the King over all the earth. Praise him with a psalm! ⁸ God reigns above the nations, sitting on his holy throne. ⁹ The rulers of the world have gathered together with the people of the God of Abraham. For all the kings of the earth belong to God. He is highly honored everywhere.

Psalm 93:1-5 The LORD is king! He is robed in majesty. Indeed, the LORD is robed in majesty and armed with strength. The world stands firm and cannot be shaken. ² Your throne, O LORD, has stood from time immemorial. You yourself are from the everlasting past. ³ The floods have risen up, O LORD. The floods have roared like thunder; the floods have lifted their pounding waves. ⁴ But mightier than the violent raging of the seas, mightier than the breakers on the shore-- the LORD above is mightier than these! ⁵ Your royal laws cannot be changed. Your reign, O LORD, is holy forever and ever.
