The Bread of Life- Sunday, April 19, 2020



- **Opening Prayer**

Invite Jesus into your worship time, asking His Spirit to have freedom to move among you.

- **Quieting**

Take five minutes to quiet your heart and mind. Breathe deeply. Prayerfully hand all distractions over to the Lord, allowing Him to take them so that you can enter into this time with an undivided mind.

Also, allow any sins and shortcomings of this past week to come to mind, and ask the Lord's forgiveness for each. Trust that through Jesus Christ, His forgiveness is for you. Use this time of repentance to bring you into depth of joyful relationship with Christ.

- **Scripture Reading**

**Hebrews 1:3** The Son radiates God's own glory and expresses the very character of God, and he sustains everything by the mighty power of his command.

**Psalms 145:14-18** The LORD helps the fallen and lifts those bent beneath their loads. The eyes of all look to you in hope; you give them their food as they need it. When you open your hand, you satisfy the hunger and thirst of every living thing. The LORD is righteous in everything he does; he is filled with kindness. The LORD is close to all who call on him, yes, to all who call on him in truth.

**Matthew 10:29-31** What is the price of two sparrows – one copper coin? But not a single sparrow can fall to the ground without your Father knowing it. And the very hairs on your head are all numbered. So don't be afraid; you are more valuable to God than a whole flock of sparrows.

**Romans 10:9-10** If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. <sup>10</sup> For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by confessing with your mouth that you are saved.

**Hebrews 7:23-25** There were many priests under the old system, for death prevented them from remaining in office. <sup>24</sup> But because Jesus lives forever, his priesthood lasts forever. <sup>25</sup> Therefore he is able, once and forever, to save those who come to God through him. He lives forever to intercede with God on their behalf.
