- **Opening Prayer**

Take a few moments in silence and repentance before the Lord. Then welcome Him to move in your presence together. The Lord has something for each person today. May we hear His voice and step into His call.

- **Scripture Reading**

Psalm 27:1, 13-14 The LORD is my light and my salvation-- so why should I be afraid? The LORD is my fortress, protecting me from danger, so why should I tremble?...¹³ I am confident I will see the LORD's goodness while I am here in the land of the living. Wait patiently for the LORD. Be brave and courageous. Yes, wait patiently for the LORD.

Psalm 46:1-3, 6-7, 10 God is our refuge and strength, always ready to help in times of trouble. So we will not fear when earthquakes come and the mountains crumble into the sea. Let the oceans roar and foam. Let the mountains tremble as the waters surge!⁶ The nations are in chaos, and their kingdoms crumble! God's voice thunders, and the earth melts! The LORD of Heaven's Armies is here among us; the God of Israel is our fortress....¹⁰ "Be still, and know that I am God! I will be honored by every nation. I will be honored throughout the world."

In the national chaos and tumult of this past week, it's important that we take a moment to remember that God is still sovereign and powerful. Take time this week to dwell on these truths.

Leader: If then you have been raised up with Christ, keep seeking the things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God.
